In my career (1995-2005) as a forensic and anatomical pathologist I have effectively carried out over 18,000 autopsies and post-mortem examinations for varying reasons including suicides, homicides, deaths of soldiers, drowning, deaths from fires, bone and tooth identification, odontostomatology malpractice, assessment of medical malpractice and/or medical negligence, obstetrical and gynecological malpractice, plastic surgery malpractice, burns caused by chemical substances, evaluation of bodily injuries and disability caused by road accidents or accidents at work, examination of living victims of assault (including sexual assault), assessment of the ability to complete legal transactions, DNA paternity testing, child custody, drug use assessment / evaluations, examination of psychopaths, blood alcohol test detection, ballistics, air - hipping accidents bombings, earthquakes-floods.
